

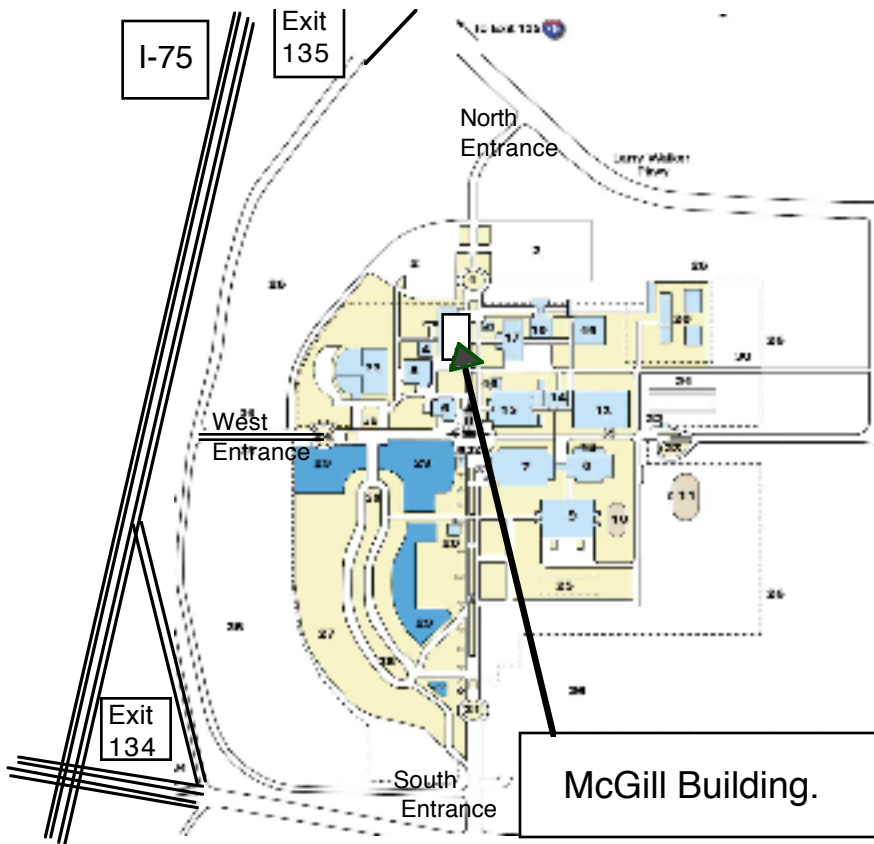
## Location:
